Criteria

This Scholarship is open for award annually to Music BMus and MA students at the University of Edinburgh. It is tenable for one year with possible renewal within the limit of three years. Preference will be given to an organist preparing for the diplomas of Associateship and Fellowship of the Royal College of Organists.

Value of Award

The award will be in the region of £500.

Closing Date

Application forms must be returned to Carolyn Mason (music@ed.ac.uk), by 16:00 pm on Friday 20 January 2023.

Competition

Each performer is expected to offer a programme lasting **35 to 40 minutes**. Particulars of works to be performed **must** be given on the application form. The applicant must indicate a suitable organ for their proposed programme.

The competition dates will be arranged upon receipt of the applications according to the availability of the required organs.
