



Professional Experience Support: UK Part 3 (ARB/RIBA)

The following is a summary of the fees payable by candidates who decide to sit the Part 3 in Scotland, supported by the Professional Studies Advisor (PSA) at the Edinburgh School of Architecture and Landscape Architecture (ESALA).

Summary of Fees January 2024

Access to RIBA PEDR System

RIBA PEDR Support – 13 months of access to the RIBA's electronic experience recording site*. The site allows candidates to record their professional work experience and have it approved by their office mentor and PSA electronically. Cost updated from £26.40 to £30.00 by RIBA 14/2/24 (Payable to the RIBA) £30.00

ESALA PSA Support

ESALA Professional Studies Support including comments and signature on 4 no. PEDR log sheets*. PSA support also covers feedback on the Experience Based Analysis synopsis and support throughout the process. (Payable to the University of Edinburgh) £130.00

ESALA Short Courses

Update in Architectural Management Course – this course covers multiple aspects of Architectural Practice in a series of presentations and related tasks. *The course is optional for those sitting the Part 3 but highly recommended.* (Payable to the University of Edinburgh) £350.00

Contract Administration Simulation Exercise - a role-playing exercise where candidates take the role of Contract Administrator on a building contract. *The course is optional for those sitting the Part 3 but highly recommended.* (Payable to the University of Edinburgh) £150.00

APEAS Examination Fees

(payable to APEAS)

APEAS administer the Part 3 Examination in Scotland. Two separate fees are payable to them:

Registration Fee (to sit the Examination) £445.00

Examination Fee £1,145.00

TOTAL £2,246.40

*Note that candidates may need to record more than 13 months/4 log sheets of experience to meet the minimum 24 months of recorded experience required to sit the Examination. Candidates should budget accordingly.
